**ARTSPIRE 2025 ART FAIR & SALE PROSPECTUS INFORMATION**

- Artspire 2025 Artist Booth Exhibits will be open Saturday, June 14, 2025 from 10:00 am to 7:00 pm. All booths must remain open for the entire length of the show.
- Exhibitors must be at least 18 years of age.
- All artwork must be acceptable for viewing by the general public. In the case of questionable content, the artist may be asked to remove the work from view.
- Seller must be the creating artist.
- Artists are responsible for collecting, reporting and paying all applicable sales taxes: [WI Sales & Tax Requirements for Temporary Events](#)
- Artspire will take place, rain or shine. Exhibitors should be prepared for inclement weather.
- Booth fees are non-refundable.
- Booth space measures approximately 10' x 10' with a 1' perimeter.
- Each artist is responsible for supplying & erecting their own *white* display booth. Tent/booth must be white and fit within the 10' x 10' area, including chairs, flip bins, and walk around space.
- Booths must be weighed down with weights or sandbags equaling at least 50 lbs. on each of the four corners. **DO NOT USE STAKES** to secure your tent. The City of La Crosse charges \$100 per stake used at Riverside Park.
- Artist check-in begins at 6:00 am. All booth set up and vehicle removal must be completed by 9:00 am. A dedicated parking area for booth artists will be assigned at check-in.

- Bathrooms and bottled water and snacks will be available to artists.
- Informed volunteers will be present to assist at booths if needed for breaks.
